## SESSION UPDATE:

Our Session meeting this month began as it always does with a short devotional by Pastor Khandjian, followed by a time of prayer. We especially lifted up the Virginia Tech situation and our own Mike Rallo who was on the college campus as a crisis counselor.

We then dismissed three committees of Session that have been inactive for about a year, the Outreach Committee, the Vision Committee, and the Worship Committee. Any of these committees can be re-established as needed by the Session.

We had the privilege this month of admitting 28 new members to our congregation. This does not include the children who have recently completed the communicant's class. They will be voted on at our May meeting. At the same time, 18 members were dismissed from the rolls. Membership count stands at just over 1,400.

The Adult Christian Education ad hoc Committee was also granted an extension from the 60-day time period to report back to Session. The extension allows the committee to report back to the Session at its June 19 business meeting. This is the next Session business meeting after the 60 days would have been up.

We also considered joining a partnership agreement with Border Evangelism and Mercy Ministries (BEAMM), one of the mission agencies of MTW we support. Some questions arose regarding the wording of the agreement, so action on the agreement was postponed until the questions can be answered.
